Across the City and the Country, Local 79 is known as the model for organizing in the Trades. Mike Prohaska was our Organizing Director before he became our Business Manager and the Local has benefitted from his knowledge and commitment. The Clean Slate has always understood that if we aren't moving forward we will be falling behind, and that drive has led to the kind of results that have allowed us to grow while other Locals have shrunk. The Organizing Department has had significant wins the last few years to protect and expand our power in the construction industry:

- 1 Wall Street, a historic \$1.5 billion conversion project turned through organizing with Gilbane removed and replaced by a union contractor.
- Successful paymaster/double-breasting campaign where we signed the top 5 contractors who had used paymasters or double-breasted to full agreements, firming up our presence in the commercial market
 - Schimenti (Paymaster Campaign)
 - Petretti (Paymaster Campaign)
 - Bravo (Double-breasting Campaign)
- Reidy (Paymaster Campaign)
- Archstone (Double-breasting Campaign)
- Between organizing efforts and Mike Prohaska's successful meetings with the largest affordable housing developers in the city we have secured historic wins to put Local 79 members to work in what had been 100% non-union affordable housing market.
